The swap meet has a new location this year. It's in Antioch at the Methodist church at a 1/3 of the cost of holding it at the fairgrounds. Dave Palmer will send out information as to its exact location. Someone mentioned that so far 30 tables had been purchased.

Elections of Club Officers

Several members expressed their satisfaction with the individuals currently holding offices. They asked if we could keep the same people because of the fine job they were doing.

Motion was made and it was seconded and voted on by all. It passed unanimously so all current officers will remain in their posts for another year.

Discussion:

Several members expressed an interest in getting new ideas for fun-flys like limbo and spot landing etc. It was brought up that the club has had these types of event in the passed and would like to do it again.

The topic of getting more kids involved in RC flying also was discussed. It was mentioned that the Civil Air Patrol may have an interest in coming out to the field. A motion was made to have John look into purchasing a "Club Trainer" plane. Motion seconded and passed and he was given a limit of \$279 plus tax to purchase a plane. He agreed to check with the club before the actual purchase.

Lawn mower situation. Tom plans this week to try and swap the motor and carburetor out on the donor mower.

Members would like picnic tables with seats to be moved out of the flight pit area. Tom said they could take care of that this week.

Discussion of a digital weather station was brought up by Clyde Fussell. He personally owns one and thought club might find the information it provided very helpful. He can get one from Bargain Hut for \$69.00. Motion was made to purchase the station if the service range is adequate. It was seconded and it passed. Clyde said there is a 30-day return policy if the club feels it is not working out.

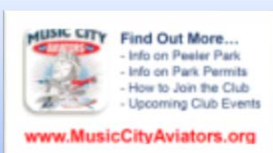
